Gerald R. Ford Presidential Museum 303 Pearl Street NW, Grand Rapids, MI 49504

Permanent exhibits allow visitors to participate in history while reviewing the lives of President and Mrs. Ford. A succession of feature exhibits draws upon the holdings of the entire Presidential Libraries System, Smithsonian Institution, and National Archives. Visitors can also see President Ford's and Betty Ford's burial site.

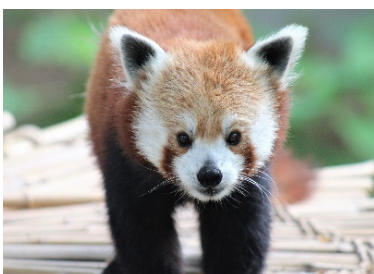


Grand Rapids Public Museum 272 Pearl St NW, Grand Rapids, MI 49504

This museum features world-class exhibitions on science, history and culture. Stroll through a full-scale detailed re-creation of Grand Rapids in the 1890s, ride a 1928 Spillman Carousel and visit the Chaffee Planetarium (*separate fees apply*).

Over 2,000 animals including tigers, lions, bears, otters, chimpanzees, red panda, and many more. Adventure experiences include a zip line, ropes course, gem sluice, and funicular (tram). Interactive animal exhibits including a walk-thru budgie aviary and wallaby yard, along with camel rides and a petting coral.
